Food Emergency Contacts

If you are responsible for public safety:

- Do you know how to recognize a food emergency?
- Do you know what to do if you suspect one?
- Do you know who to contact?

A food emergency is a situation where food contamination has happened or could potentially happen. A food emergency includes a possible food poisoning outbreak, a flood, a fire, a food truck or train crash, chemical spill or other disaster. The Wisconsin DATCP-Division of Food Safety regulates food produced in Wisconsin by commercial processing companies. Our inspection staff is a valuable resource during or after an emergency.
