NAPIS Reporting Deadlines: November 1st and November 10th

This year's deadline to enter in Title III services and make sure all client and service data is accurate for the reporting period October 2018-September 2019 will be November 1st!

Please also have your <u>September 2019 claim form</u> turned into GWAAR at <u>fiscal@gwaar.org</u> by November 10th.

Please ensure your SAMS data and financial submissions are up to date. Whatever we have received by this date will be used for the Federal NAPIS report to show your expenses against the services you have provided.

It is critically important to provide accurate data for GWAAR and the State to use when submitting Federal NAPIS reports. Your data is used for current funding purposes and potential funding and advocacy purposes – especially at the local level.
