



Have You Planned for a COVID-19 Emergency?

The Nutrition Team at GWAAR wants to expand the conversation and help you come up with discussion ideas. How will you serve customers during a COVID-19 outbreak affecting your program? Several programs are in this situation right now. You could have a staff member test positive and need to quarantine, or maybe the whole office is exposed. Perhaps your food vendor has staff who test positive and they are unable to provide meals. Here are some questions and suggestions to get you started or add to your current plan.

- What would happen if your program had to shut down?
- Who can cover for you? Does that person know SAMS and other important procedures?
- What if your meal provider must shut down?
- How will participants be notified in the event meals can't be delivered?
- How will you prioritize your participants?
- Know and read your counties/tribes Emergency Preparedness Plan.
- Send out a request for updated contact information to your participants before an emergency arises.
- Cross train your staff. Use the two-weeks on two-weeks off plan.
- Prioritize your participants by need or nutrition risk.
- Have shelf stable meals available if possible.
- Include partnerships in your plan. Work with restaurants to have a procedure in place to provide meals and delivery by utilizing restaurant staff.
- Create partnerships with caterers, hospitals, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, schools and grocery stores to be a part of your emergency plan to provide meals.

We hope this helps to get the conversation started. Please reach out to your GWAAR Nutrition Representative for assistance. We are here to help you.
