Policy Revision

Limits on Title III-E Supplemental Services Expenditures

Current Policy

The Department currently limits counties and sub-contracted agencies administering the National Family Caregiver Support Program (Title III-E of the Older Americans Act) to spending no more than 20 percent of its annually allocated funds on supplemental services for enrolled caregivers.

DHS/BADR temporarily waived this 20% limit during CY2020 and CY2021 to accommodate the needs of family caregivers during the COVID-19 pandemic.

New Policy

Beginning immediately, counties and sub-contracted agencies may permanently exceed the 20% limit. Future levels of supplemental services should be made in consultation with program participants using the [Family Caregiver Support Programs Needs Assessment](#).

All other previously published policies for the Title III-E (NFCSP) remain in force.
