Older Americans Act Reauthorization

In 2025, the Older Americans Act (OAA) will celebrate its 60th anniversary! The OAA is currently reauthorized through Sept. 30, 2024. A strong OAA reauthorization is key to ensuring a network of national, state, tribal, and community-based organizations can plan for and implement programming that aims to ensure all older adults, especially the most vulnerable, can age well with health and economic security.



The Senate Committee on Health, Education, Labor and Pensions (HELP), of which U.S. Senator Tammy Balwin is a member, is overseeing the 2024 reauthorization of the OAA. The HELP committee held a hearing on Thursday, March 7. You can view the hearing here.

Following the hearing, the HELP Committee Chairman Sanders (I-VT) and committee members released a bipartisan **Request for Information (RFI)** to give stakeholders an opportunity to help shape the goals and priorities for OAA reauthorization. The Committee is specifically seeking feedback on the effectiveness of pandemic-era flexibilities and policies from the 2020 reauthorization.
