

Caregiver Coordinator Impact Game

Time: 30–45 minutes

Format: Small group challenge + share-out + prizes

Purpose: Reinforce grant concepts by applying them to real-world Caregiver Coordinator scenarios

How It Works:

1. **Break into 5 Small Groups** (approx. 10/group; breakout rooms online.)
2. Each group is assigned a focus area; some groups will have same **focus area**:
 - Increasing Awareness
 - Building Partnerships & Engagement
 - Strengthening Services & Supports
 - Ensuring Financial & Workplace Security
3. **Challenge Prompt (5–10 min brainstorm)** shared at the beginning of the day:
“Based on what you’ve learned today, brainstorm one realistic activity or outreach strategy you can implement in your local caregiver program that supports your focus area. Bonus if it’s something simple, free, or already underway.”
4. **Share Out (2–3 min per group):**
 - Groups present their idea in 1–2 sentences.
 - **Note Taker:** jot down each idea on a shared screen.
5. **Reflect + Vote + Prizes:**
 - As a group, quickly vote (show of hands) on:
 - Most *replicable* idea
 - Most *creative* idea
 - Most *impactful* idea
 - **Note Taker:** Compile all ideas into a follow-up handout or shared doc.

Outcome:

- Reinforces key grant areas with practical implication.
- Encourages peer learning.
- Involves of both in-person and virtual attendees.
- Ends the day with energy, creativity, and positive reinforcement.
