CG AFCSP Case Management	Hour	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	Staff time spent coordinating services for individual AFCSP participants
CG AFCSP Other Goods and Services	Unit	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	Goods and services provided on a limited basis to compliment the care provided by Caregivers when needs cannot be met through traditional funding sources or existing community programs. Examples include home services (home repair and modifications, assistive devices/technology, home security and safety, and consumable supplies), and transportation/assisted transportation.
CG AFCSP Outreach	Activity (Recorded as Aggregate Event vs. Individual Service)	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	One-on-one contacts with Caregivers initiated by an agency or organization to encourage their use of existing services and benefits. Does not include a group activity that involves contact with several current or potential Caregivers/individual participants (see Public Awareness definition).
CG AFCSP Public Awareness	Activity (Recorded as Aggregate Event vs. Individual Service)	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	Contacts with a group of older adults, their Caregivers, or the general public, to inform them of services or resources available within their communities. Examples include but are not limited to health fairs, publications, newsletters, brochures, Caregiver conferences, publicity or mass media campaigns, and other similar informational activities in accordance with state policy. These activities are directed at groups and large audiences.
CG AFCSP Respite, Adult Day	Hour	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	A service in which a care recipient attends a supervised, protective, and congregate setting during some portion of a day and an overnight stay does not occur, that allow the Caregiver rest or relief.
CG AFCSP Respite, Chore	Hour	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	A service at the home of care recipient or caregiver that provides the caregiver relief from home chore responsibilities, such as lawn mowing, snow shoveling, cleaning gutters, raking leaves, waterproofing, fixing broken items, or similar tasks.
CG AFCSP Respite, Homemaker	Hour	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	A service at the care recipient's or caregiver's home. Can include chores such as doing laundry, household cleaning, dishwashing, or similar tasks,
CG AFCSP Respite, In-Home General	Hour	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	An in-home service from a skilled provider or volunteer providing short-term, temporary support to the care recipient, such as a visiting nurse or friendly visitor.

CG AFCSP Respite, Other	Hour	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	Any form of respite requested by the participant that does not fall into one of the other AFCSP respite categories.
CG AFCSP Respite, Overnight Facility	Hour	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	A service in which a care recipient is placed in a facility (such as a nursing home, assisted living facility, or hospital) for an overnight stay. Service occurs on a temporary and intermittent, occasional, or emergency basis and allows the Caregiver rest or relief to do other activities.
CG AFCSP Respite, Personal Care	Hour	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	An in-home service for the care recipient to receive personal care, such as bathing, haircuts, nail care, or similar services.
CG AFCSP Respite, Self Care	Hour	AFCSP (CG)	Goods, services, and admission to activities that promote the health and well-being of the family Caregiver, such as attending a class or event, participating in a hobby or social event, or receiving personalized self-care designed to reduce stress.
CG AFCSP Support Groups	Session	AFCSP (CG), AFCSP (No CG)	A service led by a facilitator to discuss common experiences and concerns and develop a mutual support system for Caregivers and their families. Support groups are typically held on a regularly scheduled basis and may be conducted in person, over the telephone, or online. Can be led by a lay person, health care professional, or both. Does not include “Caregiver education groups,” “peer-to-peer support groups,” or other groups primarily aimed at teaching skills or meeting on an informal basis without a trained facilitator.
